<p><b>Archery Range</b> - 16 targets and bows / Ages: 6+</p> <p>At our archery range, participants will learn the proper way to take aim and make a bullseye with helpful instruction from our staff. Archery is an activity open to any person, regardless of ability, and is a different kind of team sport which can teach patience, self-control, and discipline. <p><b>BB Gun Range</b> - 16 stations with targets / Ages: 6+</p> <p>Located next to our Archery Range, we have 16 BB spots to practice your sharp shooting skills. Staff will instruct each group on the safety features of all equipment and help participants practice correct handling.
